Agenda Item No. 1. Confirmation of the Minutes of the 12th SLTC held on 26.10.2017

Decision

The SLTC confirmed the Minutes of the 12th SLTC held on 26.10.2017.

Agenda Item No. 3 and Decision: Approval of DPRs for recommendation to SHPSC

The 12th SLTC had reviewed 33 projects amounting to Rs.96.28 Cr. from six mission cities viz. Kozhikode, Alappuzha, Trivandrum, Thrissur, Palakkad and Kollam

The Committee decided to recommend the 24 projects amounting to Rs.66.4 Cr. for the consideration of SHPSC.

Action Taken: The 24 DPRs amounting to Rs. 66.40 Cr. were accorded administrative sanction (AS) and G.O. has been received vide G.O. (Rt) 3652/2017/LSGD dated 13.11.2017.

Decision:

The Committee noted the Action Taken Report of the 12th SLTC meeting.

Agenda Item No. 3. TRIPARTITE AGREEMENT WITH KMRL FOR URBAN TRANSPORT & PARKS PROJECTS IN KOCHI AND KOZHIKODE CORPORATIONS.

In the 7th SHPSC held on 14.07.2017, it was decided to formalize the tripartite agreements between the Secretaries of Corporations of Kochi & Kozhikode – Kochi Metro Rail Limited (KMRL) – The Mission Director, AMRUT towards the implementation of Urban Transport & Park Projects in Kochi and Kozhikode Corporations.

The draft tripartite agreement is prepared and submitted by KMRL for the final approval from SLTC and signing with ULBs and Mission Directorate, for the initiation of projects.

SLTC has deliberated on the various conditions proposed by KMRL in the agreement and provided its decision as below:.

3.1 Payment of Project Cost

KMRL requires that “The Secretaries of ULB shall release 50% of project cost as advance to KMRL on signing of contract agreement with the contractor selected for the project. Balance amount will be released to KMRL depending on the progress of work as per agreed mile stones and partial utilization certificate from KMRL”.

SLTC has no objection on the above subject to the final approval to be obtained from the next SHPSC.

3.2 Payment schedule of PMC / Centage charges

PMC/Centage charges suggested by KMRL are:

Milestone 1	1 st Week of November 2017	Signing of MoU /agreement	20% of total remuneration + GST

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3.3 Centage charges payable to KMRL

KMRL has proposed centage charges varying from 5 % to 8 % based on the cost of individual projects.

However, as per the G.O. 1 and 2 (given below) were mentioned and SLTC observed that the centage charges should be between 3.25 % and 5% based on the total project cost.

SLTC has decided that the matter may be placed before the next SHPSC for review and approval.

Decision taken:

3.1 SLTC approved the suggestion of KMRL of 50% advance payment of project cost subject to final approval from next SHPSC.

3.2 SLTC decided on the schedule of Centage charges of KMRL as per its recommendations stated earlier, subject to final approval from next SHPSC.

3.3 SLTC decided that the issue of centage charges of KMRL may be placed before the next SHPSC and obtains its review and approval.

For the projects with project cost 50 lakh and above only, the DPR will be prepared by KMRL (end to end support) and for all other projects the DPR will be prepared and executed by ULB.

Agenda Item No. 4. Approval of DPRs for recommendation to SHPSC.

The Mission Directorate has received 6 projects amounting to Rs.40.21 Cr from three mission cities viz. Palakkad, Thrissur and Kannur

The Mission Directorate has also received 14 projects amounting to Rs. 74.25 Cr. from three mission cities viz. Kochi, Thrissur and Kannur as an additional Agenda.


Decision :

The committee decided to recommend 15 projects amounting to Rs. 58.07 Cr for the consideration of SHPSC.


