Minutes of the third meeting of the Apex Committee of Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) 2.0 held under the Chairmanship of Secretary (HUA) on 04.07.2022 from 03:00 PM to 04:30 PM

The Additional Secretary and National Mission Director (AMRUT) welcomed Secretary (Housing and Urban Affairs), other members of the Apex Committee and participating officers from State/ UT Governments. She initiated the discussion on agenda of the meeting through detailed presentation on items of the agenda. The list of participants is at Annexure-C.

Discussion on the agenda held in the meeting and its outcome and decision taken thereon by the Apex Committee is stated in following paragraphs.

1. Review of progress of AMRUT 1.0:

At the outset, Additional Secretary & National Mission Director (AMRUT) apprised the Apex Committee about the physical and financial achievements in implementation of Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT).

A. FINANCIAL PROGRESS

B. PHYSICAL PROGRESS

Against the total SAAPs of ₹77,640 crore, Detailed Project Reports (DPRs) have been approved by the States/UTs for projects worth ₹83,030 crore. Some States/UTs have taken projects in excess of approved SAAPs for which, the entire additional cost will be borne by the respective State/UT.

Out of the approved DPRs of ₹83,030 crore, contracts have been awarded for projects worth ₹82,328 crore, including completed projects of ₹28,914 crore. Further, for projects worth ₹671 crore, Notice Inviting Tenders (NITs) have been issued and for remaining approved Detailed Project Reports (DPRs) costing ₹31 crore, NITs are to be issued.

Decision:

- States/UTs were reminded that funding for ongoing projects of AMRUT 1.0 has been allowed till 31.03.2023 only and therefore, States/UTs need to expedite completion of the projects. In case of projects where feasibility of completion before due date is low, the **Committee directed** States/UTs to stop such projects at an appropriate stage and take up the remaining part of the project from other sources. Further, in case of such projects that have got stuck over a period of time due to various issues or where, there was very low physical progress (less than 10%) or where tenders were yet to be awarded, the Committee advised the States/UTs to drop such projects and take them up in AMRUT 2.0
- To be able to claim further funds, States/UTs were asked to expedite expenditure and directed to follow the new fund flow procedures as per Ministry of Finance O.M No. 1(13)/PFMS/FCD/2020 dated 23.03.2021 & 23.03.2022. States/UTs were also informed that balance funds against their eligibility would be released in instalments of 25% on submission of UCs and therefore, States need to expedite the pace of expenditure.
- Further, all States/UTs were advised to look into the parks/green spaces developed under AMRUT Mission as the same are not being maintained properly.
- Additionally, all States/UTs were informed that despite repeated reminders, they are yet to clear their pending dues to EESL against replacement of streetlights. The Apex Committee therefore directed the States/UTs to clear their dues as further funds against the XVth Finance Commission recommendations would only be released to them after clearance of pendency.

Decision:

- i. Committee approved the SWAPs submitted by Chandigarh, Sikkim and Rajasthan.
- ii. Committee discussed tertiary treated water usage by UT of Chandigarh and asked them to explore its supply to industries with usage charge.
- iii. Govt. of Sikkim was advised to complete the projects taken under SWAP in two years and accordingly, revise the completion timelines on the AMRUT's portal.

Decision:

- i. Committee approved the Special tranche of SWAPs of all these States/UTs viz. Assam, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Odisha, Manipur, Puducherry, Delhi, Ladakh, Rajasthan and Gujarat.
- ii. All States/UTs were directed to closely monitor the work of water body rejuvenation at regular intervals so that it can be quantified and evaluated at a later stage especially where desilting has been proposed.
- iii. All States/UTs were directed to ensure timely implementation and to keep vigil on all work done in water body rejuvenation projects.
- iv. All States/UTs to appoint one nodal officer for Water Body Rejuvenation Projects under AMRUT 2.0 who would be accountable for all works done in such projects.
- v. All States/UTs are to take up temple tanks and other traditional water bodies, *Baolis* and *Vavs* requiring rejuvenation in their Special SWAPs. States/UTs were also advised to

appoint special contractors for such projects who specialise in dealing with and restoring such historical assets.

- vi. Govt. of Odisha was requested to share its SOP for rejuvenation of water bodies, so that the same may be studied and emulated by other States/UTs as per their local conditions.
- vii. Govt. of Delhi was directed to check ownership of land where water bodies exist in the NCR and to coordinate with Delhi Development Authority for the purpose. Committee also asked Govt. of Delhi to take up traditional Water Body needing rejuvenation.
- viii. Govt. of Rajasthan is to include “*Bawadis*” under their SWAPs in the regions of *Shekhawati/ Marwad* by involving the Conservationist Architects for water body rejuvenation.
- ix. Govt. of Gujarat to identify and take up projects related to rejuvenation of “*Vav*” in the State.
