### Agenda Item No.29.4.1: Kollam Corporation – SWD Sector – Administrative Sanction for a New Work:

As per the letter no. CSSS1/ 19118/ 22 dated 13.07.2023 the Secretary, Kollam Corporation, requested to place the agenda for approval of Administrative Sanction for a new Storm Water Drainage sector work. The details are as follows:


- ❖ The proposed SWD cleaning equipment is necessary for the ULB to avoid flooding and are part of their disaster management activities
