Survey and GIS Mapping of Storm Water Drainage, Sewerage Network & Assets, Water Supply Network & Assets in 9 AMRUT Mission Cities (Thiruvananthapuram, Kollam, Kochi, Thrissur, Kozhikode, Kannur, Alappuzha, Guruvayur, and Palakkad)

Objective of the Work:

The objective of this assignment is to conduct GIS-based field surveys and mapping of Storm Water Drainage, Sewerage Network & Assets, Water Supply Network & Assets, and to develop an integrated geospatial database and Web GIS dashboard. This initiative will support evidence-based planning, monitoring, and management of urban water infrastructure under AMRUT Mission Kerala.

Scope and Intent:

The Mission Director, AMRUT SMMU invites electronic tenders from accredited/empaneled agencies by the Government of Kerala who are technically competent, and financially sound with experience in GIS-based urban infrastructure surveys and mapping for undertaking the Survey and GIS Mapping of Storm Water Drainage, Sewerage Network & Assets, Water Supply Network & Assets in 9 AMRUT Mission cities.

This strategic initiative aims to strengthen the state's waterbody rejuvenation, stormwater management, and digital asset management frameworks through the creation of a city-wide GIS-based digital inventory and a Web GIS Dashboard for planning, monitoring, and decision support across Kerala's AMRUT cities.
