### ORDER

The 11th SHPSC of AMRUT 2.0 has considered proposal for ratification of Tender Excess and Revision of Administrative Sanction Due to Tender Excess and Change from DSR 2018 to DSR 2021 projects under Water body Rejuvenation Sector: AMRUT 2.0 of ULBs, as detailed below;

2. As per the SHPSC decision, for 9 AMRUT 1.0 cities, 75% of the amount due to tender excess may be met by the ULB, and the remaining 25% may be met by the State. For AMRUT 2.0 cities, 50% of the amount due to tender excess may be met by the ULB, and the remaining 50 % will be met by the State

3. Based on the recommendations of the SLTC, as per the minutes read as 1st paper above, the 11th SHPSC of AMRUT 2.0 has decided to accord the revision of the Administrative Sanction for the above Nine projects under Water Body Rejuvenation due to tender excess and above five projects under Water Body Rejuvenation due to PRICE revision, considering the SLTC's recommendations, subject to the following conditions:

- For AMRUT 1.0 cities, 75% of the tender excess amount shall be borne by the ULB and 25% by the State; for AMRUT 2.0 cities, the tender excess amount shall be shared equally, with 50% borne by the ULB and 50% by the State.
- Any additional cost due to the switch to DSR 2021 may be met through savings from their own waterbody rejuvenation projects or by cancelling their own projects within the same sector. If neither savings nor cancellations are available, the excess cost shall be borne by the respective Urban Local Bodies (ULBs). Descoping options have to be explored if the ULB is not willing to bear the additional cost.
- The ULBs shall submit the Municipal Council's approval

4. As per the letter read as 2<sup>nd</sup> paper above, the Mission Director, AMRUT has

requested to accord sanction based on the decision of 11<sup>th</sup> SHPSC read as 1<sup>st</sup> paper avove.

5. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord the revision of the Administrative Sanction for the above Nine projects under Water Body Rejuvenation due to tender excess and above five projects under Water Body Rejuvenation due to PRICE revision, considering the SLTC's recommendations, subject to the following conditions:

- For AMRUT 1.0 cities, 75% of the tender excess amount shall be borne by the ULB and 25% by the State; for AMRUT 2.0 cities, the tender excess amount shall be shared equally, with 50% borne by the ULB and 50% by the State.
- Any additional cost due to the switch to DSR 2021 shall be met through savings from their own water body rejuvenation projects or by cancelling their own projects within the same sector. If neither savings nor cancellations are available, the excess cost shall be borne by the respective Urban Local Bodies (ULBs). Descoping options have to be explored if the ULB is not willing to bear the additional cost.
- The ULBs shall submit the Municipal Council's approval
