

**Minutes of the 13<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Apex Committee of Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) 2.0 held under the Chairmanship of Secretary (HUA) on 26.02.2026 from 03:00 PM to 04:00 PM**

The 13<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Apex Committee of Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) 2.0 was held on 26.02.2026 at 03:00 PM under the Chairpersonship of Secretary, HUA to review the progress under AMRUT 2.0 and to consider the proposals submitted by the States/ UTs. The List of participants is at Annexure-A.

2. At the outset, Joint Secretary(I), HUA welcomed the Chair and other Members of the Apex Committee and participating officers from State/ UT Governments. Joint Secretary(I) initiated the discussion on agenda of the meeting through detailed presentation on items of the agenda.

3. The Apex Committee deliberated on the agenda and the decision taken during the meeting are as below:

**3.1. Agenda -1: Review of progress in implementation of Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) 2.0.**

3.1.1 Joint Secretary(I), HUA briefed about the progress of AMRUT 2.0. The Committee noted that projects worth ₹1,93,113 crore have been approved under AMRUT 2.0, against which DPRs worth ₹1,66,575 crore have been approved. Out of the above, projects worth ₹1,38,349 crore have been awarded.

JS(I) further highlighted that % of contracts awarded against approved projects in the States of Rajasthan, Haryana, Kerala, Uttar Pradesh, Jharkhand, Punjab and Bihar are below the national average of 69%. Similarly, Chandigarh, Manipur, Uttarakhand, Delhi and Ladakh lag behind the national average of 76% in their respective category (NE/ Hilly States/ UTs)

**Discussion:** The Committee observed that preparation of DPRs and pace of implementation may be expedited by the States. The grounding of projects needs to be fast tracked. The Apex committee urged all states to expedite execution, update physical progress regularly, and ensure quality and sustainability of outcomes.

JS(I) thereafter highlighted pending project status in AMRUT 1.0. 240 projects costing ₹16,478 crore in 25 States/ UTs had pending works worth ₹2,320 crore. It was also observed that many projects had physical/ financial progress over 95%, but had not been closed/ completed.

**Discussion:** The Apex Committee urged all States/ UTs to expedite execution, update physical progress regularly and complete the pending projects at the earliest.

### 3.2. Agenda -2: Extension of AMRUT 2.0 for the FY 2026-27:

JS(I) apprised the Committee that as the original time period of AMRUT 2.0 is scheduled to end on 31.03.2026, D/o Expenditure, M/o Finance has granted extension of AMRUT 2.0 Mission for FY 2026-27 (i.e. till 31.03.2027) only, within the existing approved financial outlay for completion of projects already considered/ undertaken. Any further extension shall be contingent upon utilization of at least 50% of the Central share.

**Discussion:** The Apex Committee instructed all States/ UTs to get their remaining SWAPs approved at the earliest. Further, all States/ UTs were directed to ensure incurring of maximum expenditure so that at least 50% of Central Share allocation for AMRUT 2.0 i.e. about ₹38,400 crore of Central funds is spent by 31.03.2027, which is a mandatory condition for further extension of AMRUT 2.0 beyond FY 2026-27.

### 3.3. Agenda -3: Consideration/ approval of State Water Action Plans (SWAPs) by the following States/UTs under Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) 2.0:

#### 3.3.1 Arunachal Pradesh

**Discussion:** State, in its explanation to high cost of household connections, replied that the cost had risen due to topography of the land, high labor cost and distance of source from proposed WTP.

**Decision:** Apex Committee **approved** the SWAP submitted by the State of Arunachal Pradesh. The State was advised to submit projects for balance CA by 31.03.2026

### 3.3.2 Punjab

**Discussion:** State submitted that cost of projects in previously approved SWAPs 1 & 2 have increased due to multiple factors such as provisioning for Solar Energy systems for WTPs, water testing labs, changes in cost due to revision in schedule of rates , changes necessitated due to detection of heavy metals in water at multiple locations and including last-mile connectivity for ULBs including scattered population. The Committee observed that the State should furnish justification for cost escalation, project-wise.

**Decision:** Apex Committee **approved** the SWAP submitted by the State of Punjab comprising of new 7 projects worth Rs.88.99 crore, subject to the CA allocation of 1836 cr.. Also, State was directed to submit the project-wise cost changes in earlier SWAPs alongwith the justification within seven days for further examination.

\*-State has reported savings of ₹1,145.62 crore (through reduced awarded cost/ revision) in CA against projects approved in previous tranches. CA in the instant tranche would be met through these savings.

**Discussion/ Decision:** Apex Committee discussed the SWAP proposed by the State and **approved** it as submitted, subject to the condition that the maximum committed CA to the State of UP for the entire Mission period would be limited to ₹8,161 crore only. Rest of the funds, if any, shall be arranged by the State from their own resources. State was also told to review the project approval process within the State in order to expedite the projects.

**Discussion/ Decision:** Apex Committee discussed the SWAP proposed by the State and approved it as submitted, subject to the condition that the maximum committed CA to the State of Rajasthan for the entire Mission period would be limited to ₹3,552 crore only. Rest of the funds, if any, shall be arranged by the State from their own resources.

### 3.4. Agenda-4: SWAP revision Requests submitted by Maharashtra, Kerala, Uttar Pradesh, A&N Islands and NCT of Delhi

The Committee was apprised of the Project Change/ Deletion/ Replacement proposals submitted by Maharashtra, Kerala, Uttar Pradesh, A&N Islands and NCT of Delhi. As per AMRUT 2.0 operational guidelines, replacement of projects beyond 10% of respective tranche of SWAP, after approval of SHPSC shall be sent to the Apex committee for consideration and approval. No expenditure shall be booked against any project proposed to

be replaced. For revisions costing less than 10% of the approved SWAP size, SHPSC is the competent authority for approval.

**Decision:** Apex Committee **approved** the proposed revision in the SWAPs of Maharashtra, Kerala, Uttar Pradesh, A&N Islands and NCT of Delhi, wherein proposed revisions were more than 10% of previously approved SWAPs.
